Preparing for the Winter Season

Parking Restrictions During Snow Episodes

Municipal Code 10.10.040

A) When there is an accumulation of 2" (inches) or more of snow, the parking restrictions provided in this section



shall be in effect. No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle on a portion of the snow route, or leave, abandon or permit to stall any vehicle, which is stalled on any portion of the snow route.

B) Parked vehicles shall be removed from all streets within the Town, including those which are not designated snow routes. Failure to remove parked vehicles from any non-designated snow route will result in the inability of snow removal from any such street.

WINTER FIRE SAFETY TIP

Heating is the second leading cause of U.S. home fires, deaths and injuries. December, January and February are the peak months for heating fires. Space heaters are the type of equipment most often involved in home heating equipment fires, figuring in two of every five fires (40%).

Facts About Home Heating Fires

- From 2013-2015, an average of 45,900 home heating fires occurred in the United States each year.
- Heating was the second leading cause of home fires after cooking.
- Home heating fires peaked in the early evening hours between 5-9 PM with the highest peak between 6-9 PM.
- Home heating fires peaked in January to 21% and declined to the lowest point from June-August.
- Confined fires accounted for 75% of home heating fires.
- 29% of the non-confined home heating fires happened because the heat source (like a space heater or fireplace) was too close to things that can burn.

Make sure your space heater

has an Automatic shut-off in case

it tips over.


