

**PROCLAMATION TO SUPPORT TOWN HALL REVITALIZATION,
PALMER LAKE, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, the 1914 constructed Town Hall in Palmer Lake is the gathering space for both public and private meetings and events; and

WHEREAS, municipal officials, staff and citizens alike benefit from the various use and traditions that take place at the Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, the roof trusses of the Town Hall have been damaged over the years and require replacement and it is a suitable time to address several improvements for this 107-year old structure to better utilize the community space; and


WHEREAS, a grant application is applied for with the State Historical Fund to further improve the Town Hall with ADA-compliant doors, restroom and kitchen facilities for years to come; and

WHEREAS, it is intended to preserve or return the Town Hall historic design, style, material, and workmanship nearest the original features, including improvements of electrical capacity and lighting and sound to benefit future gatherings.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of Trustees, Palmer Lake, Colorado, hereby supports the revitalization of this historic structure celebrating the community congregating for decades-long annual traditions and special gatherings of the Town. The Palmer Lake Town Hall is the center of a remarkable community that keeps its history vibrant and community customs alive.
