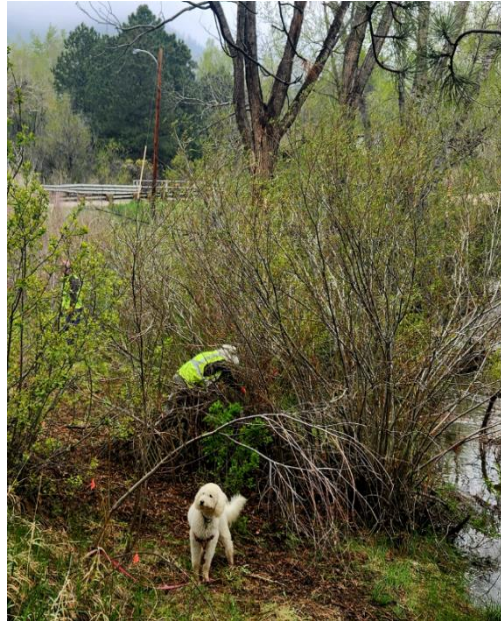


ACTIVITY FOR ELEPHANT ROCK PROPERTY!

Recent activity directed by the Board of Trustees:

- Directed staff to work with Willans to finalize lease agreement for area of premises for eco spa, amphitheater, use of maintenance shed and existing gymnasium
- Directed a community workgroup to draft a master plan for remaining property



FIRE SAFETY TIPS

Spring is Here! As the snow melts, trees bud, and longer days arrive, here are a few tips to assist with your spring cleaning.

Properly use and store gasoline

- Never use gasoline as a cleaner or to break down grease.
- Only store it in proper store gasoline containers and never bring it inside.
- Never store it in containers in the basement or occupied space in a building.
- Make sure the container is tightly capped when not in use.

Carefully dispose of rags with paint and stain

- Never leave cleaning rags in a pile. Take them outside to dry and keep them away from the home and other structures.
- Put dried rags in a metal container, make sure the container is tightly covered. Fill the container with water and detergent solution, which will break down the oils.
- Keep containers of oily rags in a cool place, out of direct sunlight and away from heat.

Inspect grills to ensure they are in good working order

- Make sure it's free of grease or fat buildup and debris.
- Check the gas tank hose on propane grills to make sure there are no leaks.

\$5 Parking Fee – See Kiosk

FREE Public parking off Hwy 105 by the baseball field & the west end of the pedestrian bridge

No dogs or animals allowed

No bathrooms on the trail. Porta potty available at the trailhead parking lot

Pack your trash out

No camping or campfires

NO fishing or any water activity is permitted on the 1st Reservoir

ONLY fishing from the shore is permitted on the Upper Reservoir

Parking by the tennis courts & playground area is reserved for parks patrons ONLY

WATER CONSERVATION - §13.24.020

To avoid waste of water and to stagger the demand in the Town's water system during the irrigation season, beginning May 15 and ending September 30 of each year, water shall be restricted as follows:

ODD numbered building addresses on Mon, Wed & Fri

EVEN numbered building addresses on Tue, Thu & Sat

No watering between 10 AM - 6 PM

NO LANDSCAPE WATERING ON SUNDAYS

- Help keep Parks and public areas clear by using using trash receptacles.
- Trash receptacles should be secured and out day of pick up only.
- Deposit fishing hooks around the lake into proper containers.
- Walk pets on a leash and clean up pet waste.
- Clear hydrants and ROW visibility.
- Clear private driveway culverts.
- Do not feed the wildlife.
- Use lake at your own risk.
- Open campfires are prohibited.
