#### 05/11 Report

Following a notice and the new trail being flagged, we have heard from numerous landowners abutting the trail area and all comments/concerns will be brought before the Board.

Staff will gather quotes to repair the town parking area to consider repair work this summer.

A lot of activity is gearing up for outdoor projects beginning - parks, roads, water in June - Steve does have to replace a raw water tank on skid B at the plant, about \$35k (capital items = over \$5000) otherwise, he will keep to strictly distribution system replacement and technology upgrades funded by ARP (approximately \$400k remaining).

A meeting with DOLA representative, Todd Leopold this week, confirmed receipt of the request letter for funds to review/revise critical issues of the land use code (subdivision and zoning code) – should know within the next week. Additionally, we are eligible to apply for tier 1 (\$200k) and tier 2 (\$1m) energy impact funds for water infrastructure or public facilities. We will assemble more details on this as funding options are required.

Status of Sign Code – PC will continue work on sign code at 5/17 workshop. We do have a number of sign permit applications pending review once the code is considered.

The ER master plan workgroup has rescheduled the kickoff meeting from 5/18 to Wed., 6/14 at TH at 1p – parties are informed of the change and posted to the town calendar.
