PW equipment operator, Blake Bloom, started 3/25

Accounting clerk anticipated to start 4/8

Interviews for Deputy Town Clerk will be the week of 4/8

Plan for PW: I received no applications for the PW Supervisor position, so initiated recruiting assistance and there is an interim candidate we will speak with later next week while recruitment continues to permanently fill the supervisor position. I will keep you abreast of that status.

Regarding PD: I would like to personally commend Lt Adam Lundy for accepting the interim position of Police Chief; and I want to congratulate Corporal Gene Ramirez on his promotion to Corporal with the dept. After numerous discussions, including input from a citizen serving in law enforcement, a mutual decision was made to bring in a consultant specializing in small law enforcement agencies to conduct a department assessment in April. It will involve staff interviews and a thorough review of several aspects of the dept policy, standards, structure, and the like, to provide a final report with recommendations to consider. This time is viewed by Administration and PD as an opportunity to proactively identify and prioritize department needs and maximize the efficiency of the dept. More on this topic will come.

The Water Department is working in the Greeley-Epworth-Shady area to relocate a water line to service Epworth residents and tee up the water line replacement on Shady, which will be a multi-year project.

The Upper Glenway roadway improvement project is anticipated to start up in June. An RFP will be issued by May for the construction activity.




