**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
PALMER LAKE SETTING THE 2019 MILL LEVIES**

WHEREAS, in accordance with state law, the Town Administrator timely prepared and submitted a proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2019 ("Budget") to the Town Board of Trustees for the Board's consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published in accordance with Sections 29-1-108 and 29-1-109, C.R.S., the proposed Budget was open for inspection by the public at the Town offices, and a public hearing was held on November 8, 2018, at the Town Hall, 28 Valley Crescent, Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, following the public hearing on November 8, 2018 the Town Board of Trustees approved the 2019 Budget and made necessary appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the funds necessary to meet projected appropriations for Fiscal Year 2019 equal the amount of \$1,963,766; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 net valuation for assessment of real property within the Town, as certified by the El Paso County Assessors, is \$34,727,490.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado as follows:

Section 1. Setting mill levies.

- A. For the purpose of meeting general operating expenses of the Town during the 2019 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 11.135 mills upon each dollar of total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town, to raise \$386,690 in revenue. This mill levy represents a temporary mill levy reduction only.
- B. In addition, for the purpose of funding the Palmer Lake Volunteer Fire Department (general fund) during the 2019 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 10.00 mills upon each dollar of total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town, to raise \$347,274 in revenue.
- C. The total mill levy to be certified is 21.135 mills.

Section 2. The Mayor of the Town and/or Town staff is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town as determined above and set.

Section 3. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase adopted by this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases adopted by this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed the Resolution, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases could subsequently be declared invalid.

Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions, orders, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Resolution or the mill levy adopted hereby are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution or motion nor revive any of the same.


