RESOLUTION NO. 18-2020

A RESOLUTION IMPOSING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE SALE OF ANY NEW WATER TAPS WITHIN THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Town of Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Palmer Lake operates a water system with certain current and anticipated future users; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees has become concerned with the status of the supply and potential demand on the Town's water system and the ability to service its customers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Palmer Lake needs sufficient time to properly evaluate the supply and demand on the Town's water system in conjunction with anticipated future additional users in consultation with the Water Department and other Town Staff; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that a delay in selling further water taps on the Town's system, said delay being temporary, for a finite and short period of time, unless sooner repealed, is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Palmer Lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:


1. There is hereby established a temporary moratorium on the sale of water taps within the Town of Palmer Lake effective until January 31, 2021, unless sooner repealed by the Board of Trustees.
2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
3. Repeal. Existing resolutions or parts of resolutions covering the same matters embraced in this Resolution are hereby repealed and all resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
