ORDINANCE NO. 7-2021

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES 01-2020 AND 03-2020 WHICH REGULATED PARKING ON TOWN STREETS AND CLOSED CERTAIN PARKING AREAS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board of Trustees previously adopted Resolution No. 06 of 2020 on March 25, 2020, which, *inter alia*., declared a state of disaster emergency within the incorporated areas of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees previously adopted Ordinance 01-2020 and Ordinance 03-2020 to regulate parking throughout the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Staff has dedicated extensive time and resources to study and address the parking situations within the Town limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees believes that the provisions of Ordinance 01-2020 and Ordinance 03-2020 are no longer necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, or general welfare of the Citizens of the Town of Palmer Lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Ordinance 01-2020 is hereby repealed.
- 2. Ordinance 03-2020 is hereby repealed.
- 3. Town Staff will continue to designate particular areas where parking is not permitted through the use of appropriate signage.
- 4. Nothing herein shall be construed to permit parking, stopping, or standing in violation of any other regulation concerning the parking, stopping, or standing of vehicles. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed supplemental to all other regulations of the Town, including the Model Traffic Code as adopted by the Town, and statutes of the State, the same to continue in control with respect to all parking matters not addressed in this Ordinance.

5. Nothing herein shall affect the provisions of 10.04.030(B), or the penalty provisions in 10.04.040, which provides in part:

No person shall park any vehicle upon any street or highway in such a manner of (sic) under such conditions as to interfere with the free movement of vehicular traffic or proper street or highway maintenance or snow removal.

- 6. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
- 7. Repeal. Existing ordinances or parts of ordinances covering the same matters embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the effective date of this ordinance.
