RESOLUTION NO. 30-2022

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE CITIZEN APPOINTMENT TO PARKS COMMISSION,
PALMER LAKE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, Palmer Lake is a statutory town organized under Part 3 of Article 4 of Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to State Statute and the Palmer Lake municipal code, the Board of Trustees is authorized to fill the offices for the Town Parks Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Commission members reviewed and voted in May to recommend approval of an applicant to fill the remaining seat on the Parks Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE OF EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following individual is recommended by the Parks Commission to fill the remaining two-year term of appointment to the Parks Commission for the Town of Palmer Lake:

Two-Year term (ending January 2023)


