ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 2016

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 2.04.120 OF
THE PALMER LAKE MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, PALMER LAKE IS A STATUTORY TOWN ORGANIZED UNDER AND AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO PART 3 OF ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 31 OF THE COLORADO REVISED STATUTES; AND

WHEREAS, ARTICLE 16 OF CHAPTER 31, C.R.S, GOVERNS THE PASSAGE OF ORDINANCES BY STATUTORY TOWNS AND CITIES; AND

WHEREAS, SECTION 2.04.120 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE DIFFERS FROM THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PASSAGE OF ORDINANCES FOR STATUTORY TOWNS UNDER ARTICLE 16 OF TITLE 31 OF THE COLORADO REVISED STATUTES; AND

WHEREAS, THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES DESIRES TO REPEAL SECTION 2.04.120 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE SUCH THAT THE ADOPTION OF ORDINANCES SHALL BE AT ALL TIMES IN CONFORMITY WITH AND GOVERNED BY STATE LAW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.04.120 of the Palmer Lake Municipal Code is hereby repealed and reserved.

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any part shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the valid judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the parts or provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Publication and Effective Date. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause notice of its contents and passage to be published or posted. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of publication.
