RESOLUTION NO. 35 - 2023

**RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE FINAL PER FOR WATER SYSTEM
IMPROVEMENTS, TOWN OF PALMER LAKE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Town of Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, Board of Trustees initiated a study of improvements to the town water system; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board received a draft preliminary report in July 2022 with evaluation, improvement needs and recommendations to address the water system in the Town of Palmer Lake; and

WHEREAS, the report was finalized in December and distributed to Board members.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Board of Trustees for the Town of Palmer Lake hereby accepts the final preliminary engineering report for water system improvements, attached here as Exhibit A.
2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
3. Repeal. Existing resolutions or parts of resolutions covering the same matters embraced in this Resolution are hereby repealed and all resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
